Pupil Premium Policy



Pupil Premium Allocation

In financial year 2016 – 1017 St. Joseph's School was allocated £136,000 additional pupil premium funding.

- The funding is spent on recruiting additional teaching assistants and teaching assistant time to support group work, guided activities, intervention and 1:1 tuition to support learners.
- A specialist speech and language therapist and support staff for targeted speech and language groups.
- Attainment of all pupils in receipt of pupil premium funding is carefully monitored, in line with the school's assessment policy.
- At St Joseph's we recognise that all pupils including those who attract pupil premium make most progress, accessing high quality teaching. All pupils, including those who attract pupil premium are expected, as a minimum, to achieve age related outcomes.
- Intervention for all pupils, and those attracting pupil premium, will be put in place if necessary to further support pupil progress.
- Interventions may be;
 - Additional to Maths and Literacy teaching
 - Responsive to morning's teaching
 - Teacher's own assessments:
 - Maths (APP + SLOB)
 - Wave 3 Materials and Springboard
 - Speaking + Listening (A Lang. in Common)
 - Phonics (L+S & ALS)
 - Word / sentence level
 - Reading (English curriculum – lower year group objectives, ALS + APP)
 - Writing (English curriculum – lower year group objectives, ALS + APP)
