Number of tickets per family: 2 (**adults only**)

You will receive your tickets during the week of the event. Each ticket will have a unique reference number that will be recorded on entry to the performance. Please keep your tickets in a safe place and remember to bring them with you on the day of the performance.

Please note that **both** performances will be professionally recorded and DVDs will be available for parents to purchase shortly after the event via the school office. Further, the performances are for adults only. It has been our experience that babies and young children cannot remain quiet for the duration of this school event and can disrupt the performance. It is such a shame when this happens as each child in the Nativity works so hard to perfect their part and each parent wishes to see their child do their best in their brief shining moment! Please respect this decision and make childcare arrangements well ahead of time. We thank you in advance for your cooperation with this matter.
