Our year 6 children have an amazing opportunity to visit Aylesford as part of the Good Shepherd Liturgy for Southwark Diocese on Wednesday 23rd May 2018.

Set in the heart of Kent, England, The Friars - Aylesford Priory - is an ancient religious house of the Order of Carmelites dating back to the 13th Century. Over the centuries and now today The Friars has become for thousands of visitors a place of peace and prayer, a venue for gathering and a work of art.

The theme of this year's service is 'The Coming of The Holy Spirit.' This is a wonderful opportunity for the Year 6 students of the diocese to come together to celebrate their time in primary school, and to spend some time in reflection and prayer in preparation for their transition to Year 7.

Your child will be travelling to and from Aylesford by coach, the cost of which will be covered by the school. We will depart from school at 9:00am and will arrive back at school in time for end of day dismissals.
