- **Date: Tuesday 22nd May 2018**
- Venue: Kew Royal Botanic Gardens, Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew, Richmond, TW9 3AE
- Time: We will leave school at 9:15am and return for 2:00pm approx.
- Travel: We will travel to and from Kew Gardens by London Underground (Tube)

Please bring your child to school at the usual time, from 8:40am. We will prepare the children and set off around 9:15am to walk to Bermondsey Tube Station.

Your child will need to be dressed in their full school uniform, as usual, including a waterproof jacket or coat and a school cap. Please remember to apply sun cream to your child's face, neck, arms and legs before school if we are due warm weather on this day.

Please could you provide your child with a healthy packed lunch for the day as we will not be on the school site at our usual lunchtime. The children will eat their packed lunch whilst we are at Kew Gardens.

Place the packed lunch in a small, sturdy carrier bag, clearly labelled with your child's name and class. Please avoid packing **food containing nuts**, too much food, glass bottles, fizzy drinks, and 'fiddly items', e.g. dairylea assemble your own snack packs! The staff will have additional bottles of water and cups for the children.

There is a cost of £2.50 for entry to Kew Gardens and children under 5 years travel for free on the London Underground.
