- Venue: Monument to the Great Fire of London, Fish St Hill, London EC3R 8AH
- Time: We will leave school at 9:15am and return for 11:30am approx.
- Travel: We will travel to and from the Monument on the 47 bus.

Please bring your child to school at the usual time, from 8:40am. We will prepare the children and set off at 9:15am to walk to Jamaica Road, where we will catch the 47 bus. Please check the weather for the day and ensure your child has a warm, waterproof coat in the event of cold, wet weather.

We will be back to school in time for lunch so a packed lunch is **not** required. Also, there are no financial costs attached to this trip.
