Important Information

The second half of the autumn term has already been full of excitement and the countdown to Christmas has begun. We have elected a brand new Green Team to help make St Joseph's a more environmentally friendly school, rehearsals for the 'St Joseph's Nativity Movie' are well underway and we have appointed new prefects in Year 6. Please note:

Managing the Symptoms of Coronavirus

Thank you to our parent community for your vigilance in managing the symptoms of Coronavirus. Please see the guidance below:

The NHS defines the symptoms of Coronavirus (including children) as:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

If your child or a member of your household displays symptoms of Coronavirus:


- 1) Call the school office to inform the school
- 2) Book a test for Coronavirus
- 3) Self-Isolate until you receive the test results
- 4) Call the school office to inform the school of the results of the test

Upon receiving the results of the test, the senior leadership team will follow appropriate guidance as to what, if any, further action needs to be taken. If you are unsure whether your child or a member of your household is displaying symptoms of Coronavirus, contact your GP or call 111 for further advice.

Advent Project

Please remember jewellery, including stud earrings are not permitted. Shaved hair patterns or unusual styles, including the use of hair products, e.g. hair gel, are not permitted and children should tie back long hair during the school day.
