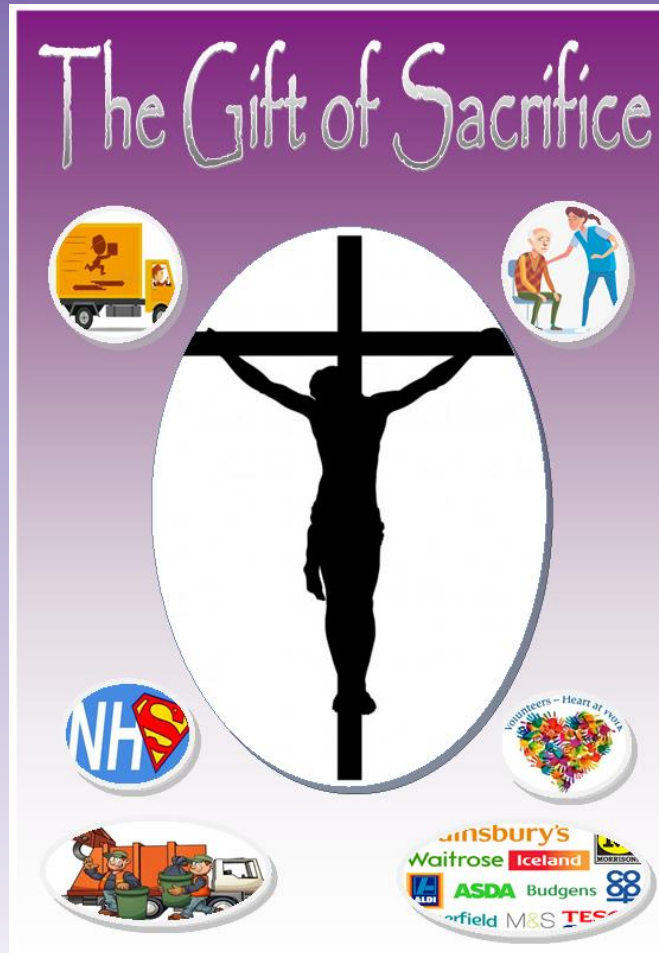

### John 12:12-16
