## English — The Sea Saw

- Planning, writing and editing a short narrative based on the fiction book 'The Sea Saw'.
- Including descriptive and imaginative adjectives to make noun phrases.
- Making inferences about how the main character might feel.
- Sequencing the events that happen in chronological order.
- Using punctuation such as capital letters and commas.

## RE— Special People & Sikhism

- Talking about the special people in our lives and how they help us.
- Understanding that there are special people in the Church of God and they celebrate the good news of Jesus.
- To understand the story of Guru Nanak.
- Understanding how Guru Nanak teaches us how to share.

## Art—Flower Head

- Recognise that flowers have different visual elements like shape, size, colour, pattern and texture.
- Learning about the work of a range of artists that take inspiration from flowers.
- Planning and creating a piece of work based on the famous artist Yayoi Kusama.

## Maths — Multiplication & Division

- Learning to recognise and make equal groups.
- Being introduced to the multiplication and division symbol.
- Learning the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Learning to divide by 2, 5 and 10.
- Doubling and halving numbers.
- Using arrays.

## Geography — Coastline

- Recognising landmarks and human and physical features to do with a harbour or sea wall.
- Using compass directions to describe locations or a route on a map.
- Comparing Whitby to another seaside town (if you have been to one, please bring in a photo).
- Reading a range of simple maps that use

## Science — Use of Materials

- Identifying and classifying the different properties of materials.
- To identify different materials in the school environment.
- Finding out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

### Music with Mr Dixon

- Learning to discriminate between longer and shorter sounds.
- Using sounds to create interesting sequences.

### PE—Games Dribbling using Feet

- Moving in different directions to avoid being tagged while moving through obstacles.
- Dribbling within a controlled space.
- Passing a ball accurately and consistently.

### PSHE - Created and Loved by God

- Understanding that God made us unique and different but we are all special.
- Knowing our different body parts.
- Knowing how to stay clean and healthy.

### Computing — We are Photographers

- Taking and editing digital photos using an iPad and computer.
- Learning different editing techniques such as crop, rotate and colour correction.
