In addition to this, the money raised has also been used for new tennis nets and frames for our Astroturf to be used at lunchtimes.

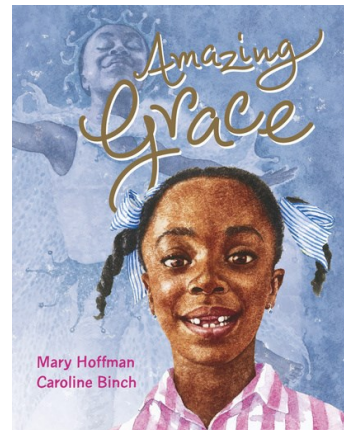
Thought for the Week
