## **Extra– Curricular Activities**

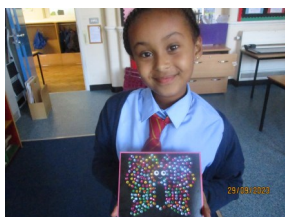
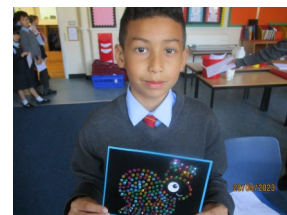
In the first half-term of this academic year, we have had a range of activities on offer after school- from athletics to baking and lots of other activities in between!
